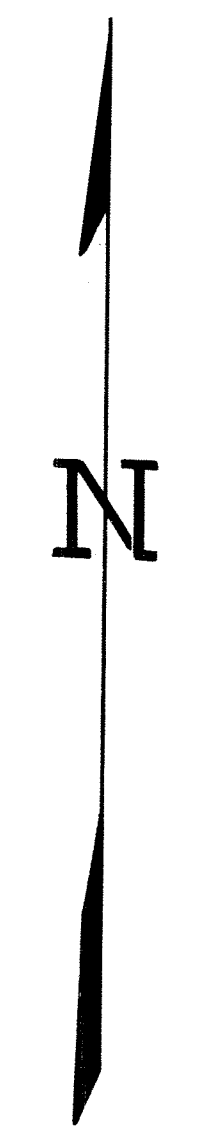

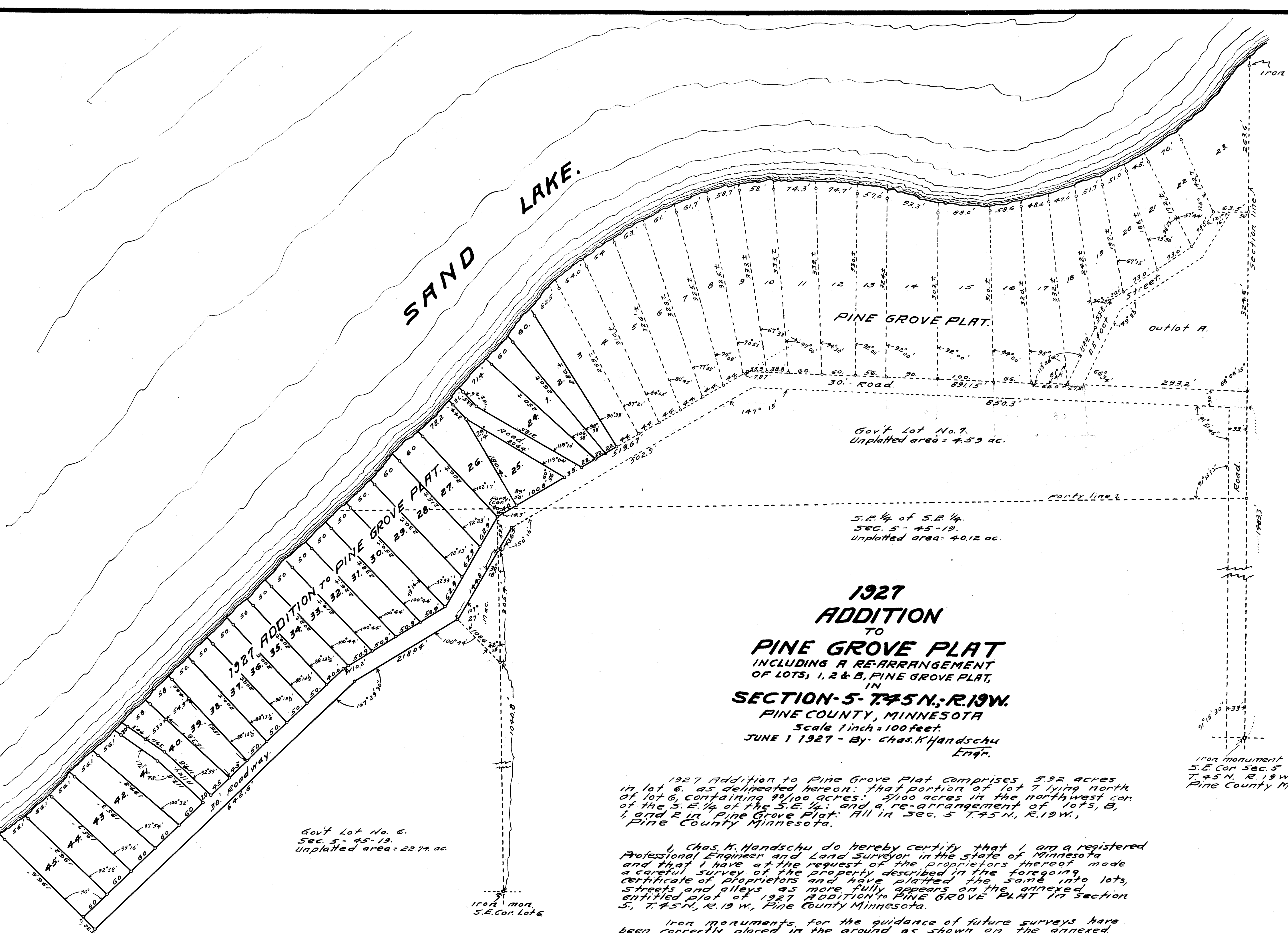

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that Richard J. Lewis and Emily J. Lewis, his wife, being the owners of the following described property lying in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota and more particularly described as follows:
 The S.E. 1/4 of S.E. 1/4 of Sec. 5; that portion of lot No. 7 lying north of lot No. 6; lots B, 1 and 2 in Pine Grove Plat. and that portion of Government lot No. 6 described as follows: Beginning on the east line of lot 6, 1040.8 feet north of the iron monument at the S.E. corner of lot No. 6, 7.45 N., R. 19 W., Pine County Minn.; thence making an angle of 42° 15' with the east line of lot 6 and proceeding in a north westerly direction a distance of 108.6 feet; thence deflecting to the left an angle of 79° 16' and proceeding south westerly a distance of 28.08 feet; thence deflecting to the left an angle of 12° 30 1/2' and proceeding south westerly a distance of 646.6 feet; thence at right angles north westerly to the shore of Sand Lake a distance of 196.6' more or less; thence following the shore of Sand Lake in a northeasterly direction to the south line of lot No. 7; thence following the south line of lot 7, to the N.E. corner of lot 6; thence south to point of beginning a distance of 2992 feet; containing 5.92 acres. All of above described in Sec. 5, T. 45 N., R. 19 W., and being desirous of platting a portion of the same into lots, streets, and alleys have caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat thereof to be made in accordance with the statutes in such cases provided.
