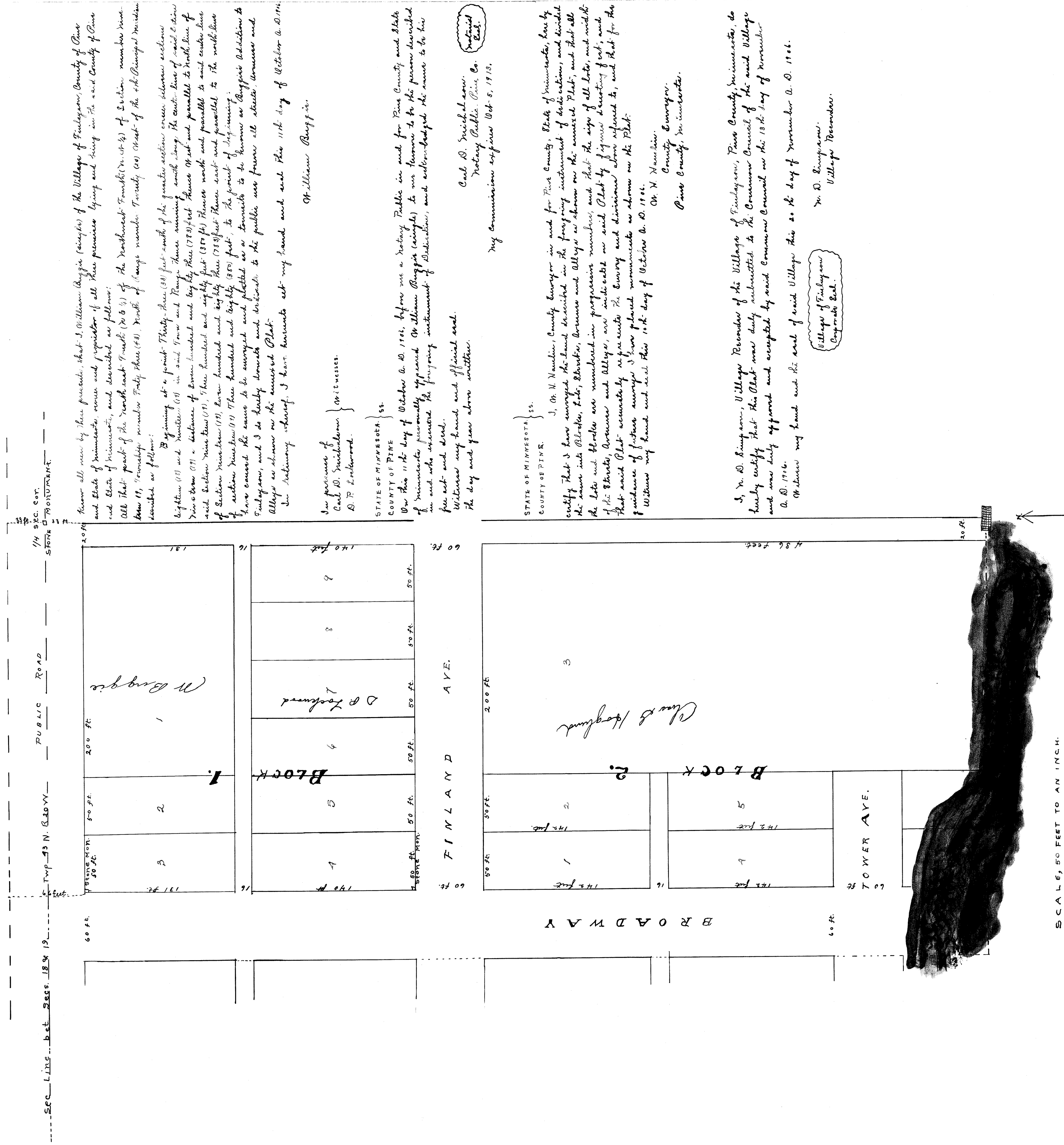

Know all men by these presents, that S. William Buggie (single) of the Village of Finlayson, County of Pine and State of Minnesota, owner and proprietor of all these premises lying and being in the said County of Pine and State of Minnesota, and described as follows:

All that part of the north east Quarter (20 1/4) of the northeast Township (20 1/4) of Section number nine town 43, range number forty three (43), north of range number twenty (20) north of the 4th Principal Meridian described as follows:

By joining at a point Thirty three (33) feet south of the quarter section corner between sections eighteen (18) and nineteen (19) in said Town and Range these running south along the east line of said Section Nineteen (19) a distance of seven hundred and eighty three (783) feet north and parallel to north line of said Section nineteen (19), then hundred and eighty feet (80) feet east and parallel to said center line of Section nineteen (19), then hundred and eighty feet (80) feet east and parallel to the north line of Section nineteen (19), then hundred and eighty feet (80) feet, to the point of beginning;

then around the same to be surveyed and platted as a townsite to be known as Buggie's Addition to Finlayson, and 3 do hereby locate and divide to the public use former all streets, avenues and alleys as shown on the annexed Plat:
