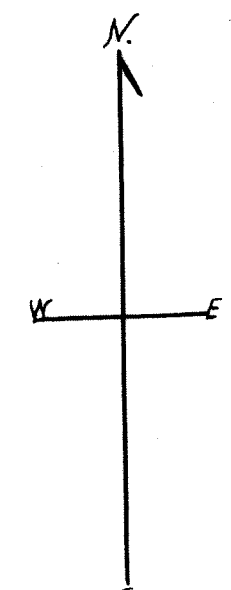
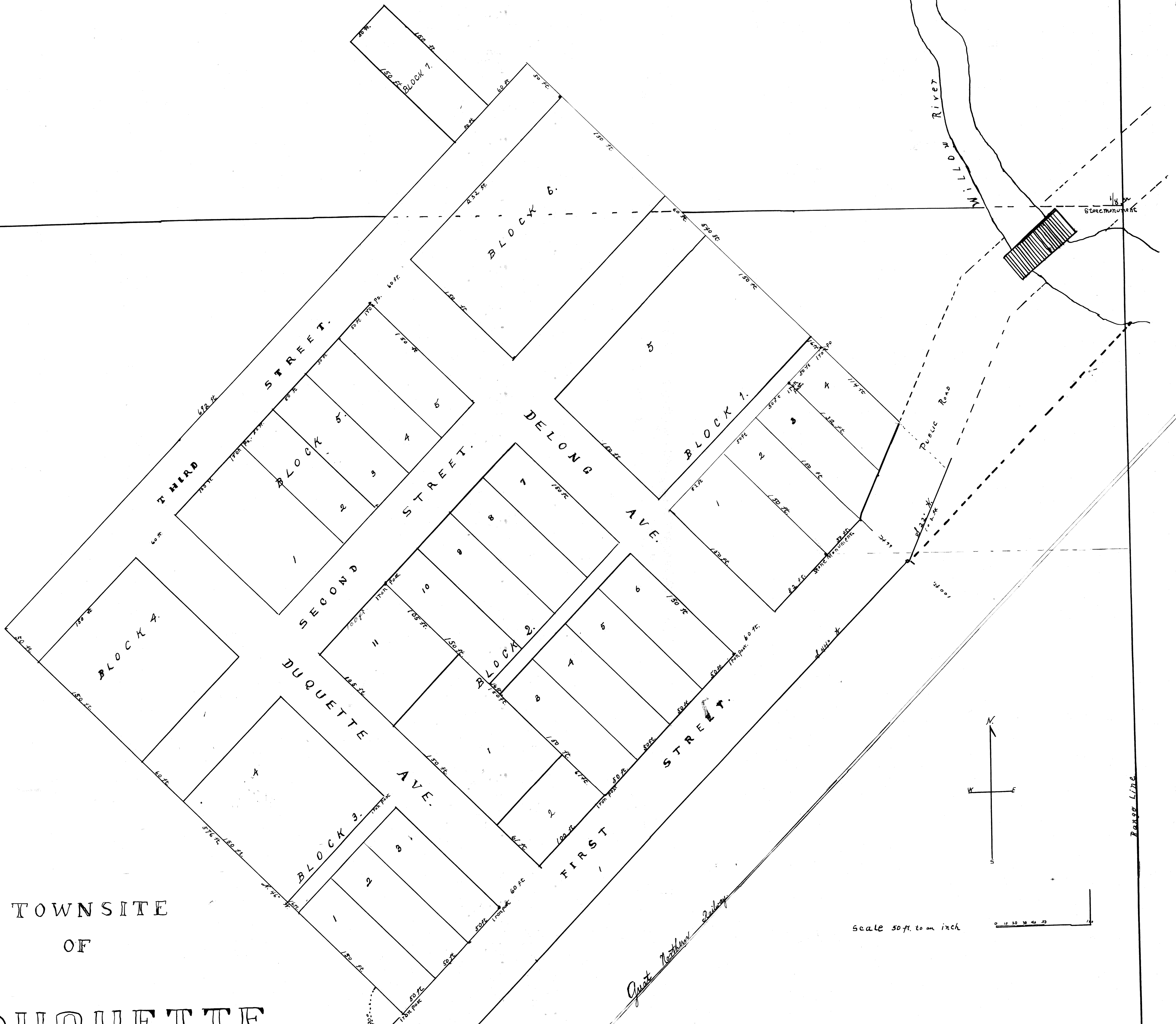


TOWNSITE

Know all men by these presents, that I Frank Duquette, do now and forever of all the premises lying and being in the County of Pine, and State of Minnesota, known and described as follows, to wit: all that part of the East half (E 1/2) of the Northeast fourth (N E 1/4) of Section Twenty-four (24), Township Forty-five (45) North of Range Eighteen (18) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, according to the United States Government Survey thereof. Beginning at a point Three hundred, sixty-five and one fourth (365 1/4) feet South and Two hundred thirty-four and one half (234 1/2) feet West of the Northeast corner of the Southeast fourth (S E 1/4) of the Northeast fourth (N E 1/4) of said Section Twenty-four (24); thence running South 44° West seven hundred and two (702) feet; thence North 46° West six hundred forty-two (642) feet; thence North 44° East six hundred ninety-two (692) feet; thence North 46° West One hundred and fifty (150) feet; thence N. 44° East Sixty (60) feet; thence South 46° East One hundred and fifty (150) feet; thence South 22° West One hundred and two (102) feet to the point of beginning; And being desirous of platting the same into town lots, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted, and the annexed plat thereof made in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided, to be the townsite of Duquette, and signs seal and execute said plat and hereby dedicate to public use forever the streets, avenues, and alleys shown on said plat.
