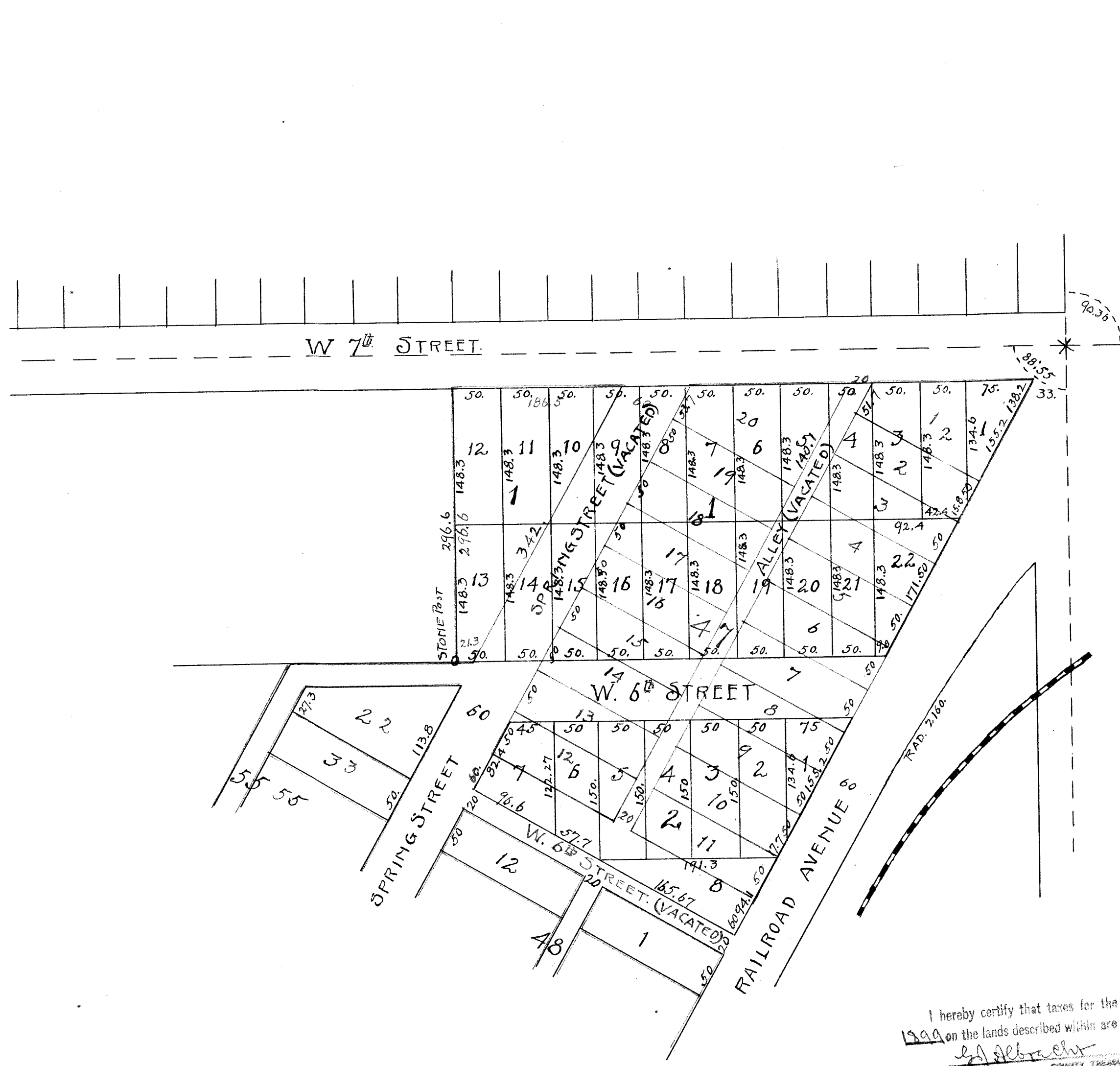


MAP OF

Know all men by these presents that the MINNEAPOLIS TRUST COMPANY, a corporation duly created organized and existing under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Minnesota, owner and proprietor of the following described premises lying and being in the County of Pine, State of Minnesota, described as follows, to wit:

All of Block forty-seven (47); lot one (1) Block fifty-five (55); all that part of Spring Street lying North of the South line of said lot one (1) Block fifty-five (55), vacated; all that part of West Sixth Street between Railroad Avenue and Spring Street Supplement to Sandstone Quarries, according to recorded plat of said Supplement on file and of record in the office of the Register of Deeds of said Pine County.

Have and do hereby cause same to be laid out, platted and subdivided in accordance with the annexed map and to be known as the First Subdivision of Sandstone Quarries, Pine County, Minnesota, and does hereby donate and dedicate to public use forever all the streets and avenues as on said map shown.
