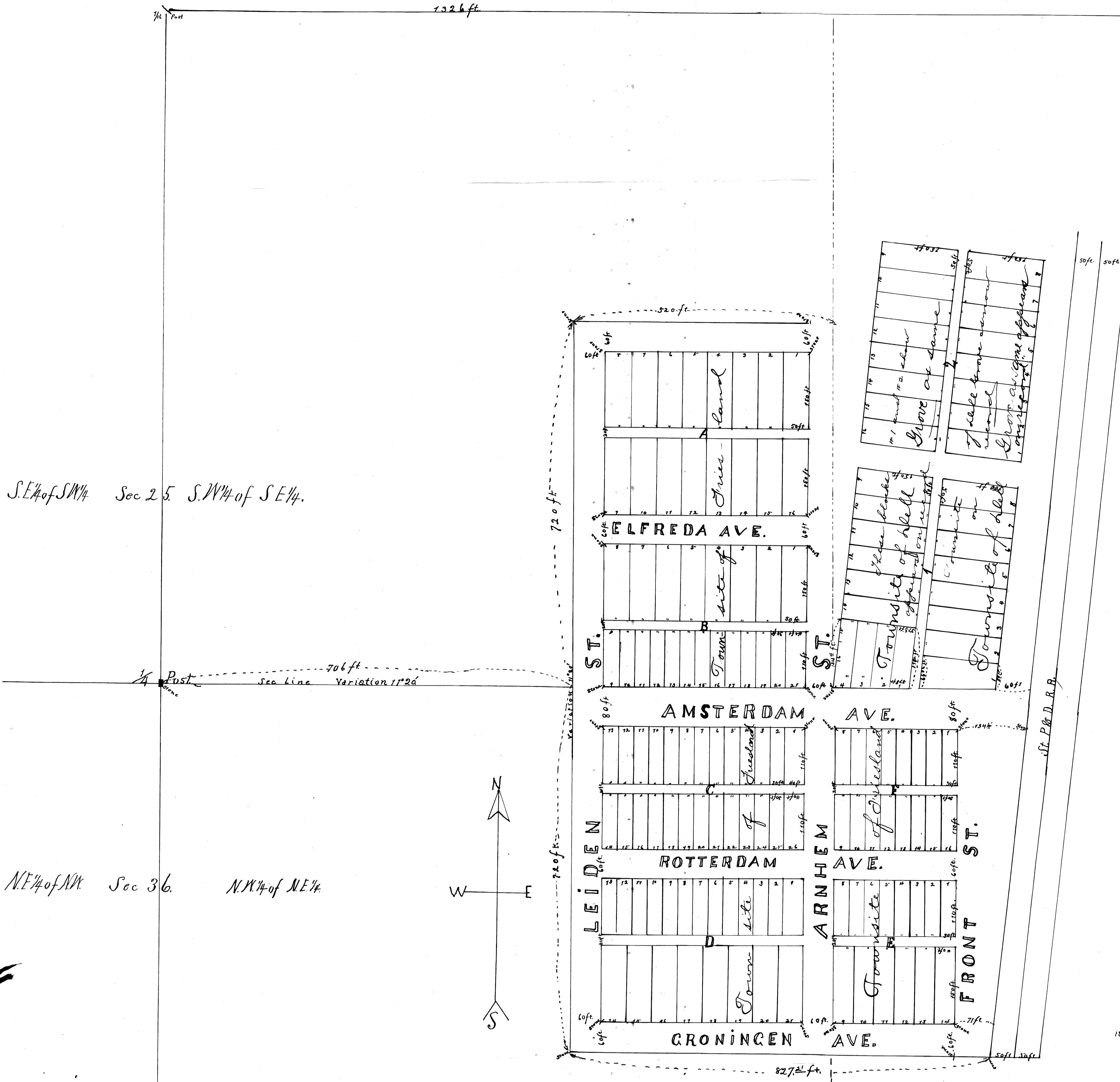


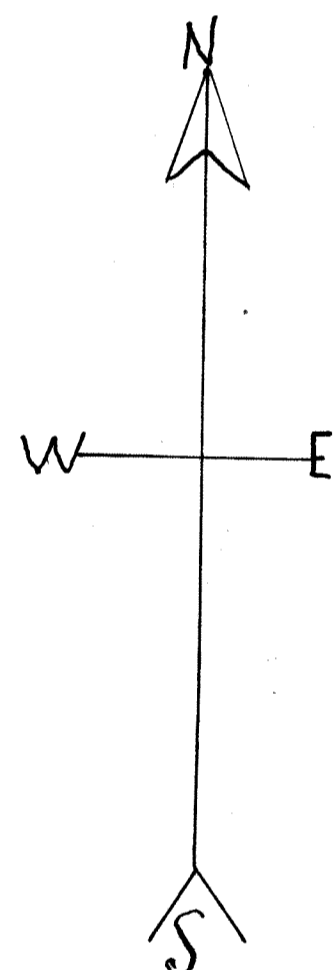
Townsite of Friesland, Pine County, Minnesota

County of Ramsey } Know all Men by these Presents, That I, Theo. F. Koch, owner and proprietor of all these premises, lying and being in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, and known & described as follows, to-wit: all of that part of the South-west quarter of the South-east quarter of Section No. Twenty-five, and the North-west quarter of the North-east quarter of Section No. Thirty-six (36) all in Township No. Forty-two (42) North of Range No. Twenty-one (21) West of the 4th Principal Meridian, lying and being West of the Right of Way of the St. Paul & Duluth Railway of Minnesota, have caused the same to be platted as a Townsite to be known as "Friesland"; that it has been laid out for town purposes as hereon shown, and do hereby donate & dedicate for the public use forever all streets, avenues and alleys as hereon shown. - In Testimony Whereof, I do hereunto set my hand and seal this 28th day of December A.
