

# PLAT OF THE TOWN OF FINLAYSON

PINE COUNTY, MINNESOTA

Know all men by these presents, that we Mary M Oldenburg and J. A. Oldenburg her husband, owners and proprietors of the following described property situated in Pine County, Minnesota, to-wit: all that part of the northwest quarter of northeast quarter (NW 1/4 of NE 1/4) or Lot three (3) of section nineteen (19) in township forty three (43) north of Range twenty (20) west, beginning at a point on the center line of said section nineteen (19) seven hundred thirty three (733) feet south of the Quarter Post between sections eighteen (18) and nineteen (19) in said township forty three (43) Range twenty (20) thence running south on the center line a distance of two hundred two (202) feet, thence south 82° 30' east four hundred seventy four and three tenths (474 3/10) feet, thence north 7° 30' east two hundred (200) feet to a stone monument, said monument being placed at the northeast corner of the original townsite of the town of Finlayson thence north 82° 30' west five hundred (500) feet to the point or place of beginning, have caused the same to be surveyed, subdivided and platted as Oldenburg's Addition to the town of Finlayson, and we hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all streets and avenues as shown on the annexed plat.

J. W. H. Hamlin, a surveyor, do hereby certify that I have surveyed, laid out and platted for and by the direction of Mary M. Oldenburg and J. A. Oldenburg, the owners and proprietors of all that part of the northwest quarter of northeast quarter (NW 1/4 of NE 1/4) of section nineteen (19) in township forty three (43) north of Range twenty (20) west, described as follows to-wit: Beginning at a point on the center line of said sec. 19-43-20, 733 feet south of the Quarter post between sec. 18+19 in said town and Range thence running south on center line a distance of 202 feet, thence south 82° 30' east 474 3/10 feet thence north 7° 30' east 200 feet to a stone monument, said monument being placed at the northeast corner of the original townsite of the town of Finlayson, thence north 82° 30' west 500 feet to the point or place of beginning, the same is platted as Oldenburg's Addition to the said town of Finlayson and that I have caused to be set stone monuments marked cross (X) at the points indicated on the annexed plat, to-wit: at the northwest corner of lot 1 of Block 1, at the southeast corner of lot 2 of Block 2, at the southeast corner of lot 4 of Block 2, at a point 60 feet east of southeast corner of lot 4 in Block 2, said point being the southeast corner of said addition, and I further certify that the annexed plat is a true and correct plat of said addition and that all the lot streets and alleys are laid out according to the dimensions as shown thereon.
