

PROVIDER'S AGREEMENT
Pine County Health & Human Services
Family Child Care

I understand and agree to abide by the following:

1. No child shall be subject to corporal punishment or emotional abuse. This includes, but is not limited to: slapping, kicking, biting, pinching, hitting, spanking, rough handling, shoving, ear or hair pulling, shaking, name calling, ostracism and derogatory remarks. Food, light, warmth, clothing, or medical care shall not be withheld from a child. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 A, B)
2. Discipline and punishment shall not be delegated to another child. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 C)
3. The separation of a child from a group to guide behavior must be appropriate to the age of the child and circumstances requiring the separation. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 D)
4. An infant shall not be separated from the group for disciplinary reasons. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 E)
5. A child shall not be separated from the group for a period longer than ten minutes. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 F)
6. A child separated from the group must be placed in an area or separate room that is well-lighted, free from hazards, ventilated, and open to the view of caregivers. (9502.0395 Subp. 2 G)
7. No child shall be placed in a locked room to separate the child from the group (9502.0395 Subp. 2 H)
8. The provider shall notify the parent on the day an injury occurs when a child's skin is broken by an animal bite or scratch. (9502.0435 Subp. 12 F)
9. The provider shall immediately notify the agent of a board of health whenever a child in care is bitten by an animal. (9502.0435 Subp. 12 G)
10. Emergency phone number of each child's physician, dentist, and parents are/will be readily available within the residence and taken on field trips. (9502.0435 Subp 8 C)
11. Suspected child abuse or neglect must be reported to the local social service agency or police. (9502.0375 Subp. 1)
12. Each child under age 9 or shorter than 4'9" being transported in a vehicle must be securely fastened in a properly installed, approved car seat. All other children shall be securely fastened in individual seat belts. (MN Statute 169.685 Subd. 5)
13. No child is permitted to remain unattended in any vehicle. (9502.0435 Subp. 9 E)
14. Milk served to children must be pasteurized. (9502.0445 Subp. 2)
15. Clean separate towels, washcloths, bedding, combs, and other personal articles are used for each child. (9502.0435 Subp. 10, 11)
16. Drinking water must be available to the children and must be offered at frequent intervals in separate or single-service cups or bottles. (9502.0445 Subp. 1 B)

17. Caregivers shall wash their hands with soap and water after each diaper change, after assisting a child on the toilet, after washing the diapering surface, and before food preparation. Hands must be dried on a single-use towel. (9502.0435 Subp. 15 B)

18. A child's hands must be washed with soap and water when soiled, after the use of a toilet or toilet training chair, and before eating a meal or snack. (9502.0435 Subp. 15)

19. Toilet-training chairs, stools, and seats must be washed with soap and water when soiled and at least daily. (9502.0435 Subp. 14)

20. Children in diapers shall be kept clean and dry. Their diapers and clothing must be changed when wet or soiled. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 B)

21. An adequate supply of clean diapers must be available for each child and stored in a clean place inaccessible to children. (9502.0435 Subp. 13A)

22. If cloth diapers are used, parents must provide a change of plastic pants for each soiled diaper change. Cloth diapers, except those supplied by a commercial diaper service, and plastic pants must be labeled with the child's name. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 A)

23. For disposable diapers, a covered diaper disposal container lined with a disposable plastic bag must be located in the diaper changing area. The container must be emptied at least daily and when full. (9502.0435 Subp. C)

24. Diaper changing must not take place in a food preparation area. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 D)

25. The diaper changing area must be covered with a smooth, non absorbent surface and washed with a solution of soap and water to remove debris and then disinfected with a solution of at least two teaspoons of chlorine bleach to one quart of water. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 D)

26. Children must be washed with a single-service disposable wipe or freshly laundered cloth before re-diapering. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 E)

27. Soiled cloth diapers, except those supplied by a commercial diaper service, plastic pants, and clothing must be placed in a plastic bag after removal and sent home with parents daily. (9502.0435 Subp. 13 F)

28. The provider shall notify the agency within 30 days of any changes in the regular membership of the household or the addition of an employee. (95020375 Subp. 2 A)

29. The provider shall notify the agency of the decision to discontinue child care and shall return their license to the agency. (9502.0335 Subp. 15)

30. The license will be posted in a prominent place in the residence. (9502.0335 Subp. 10)
