WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Rock Creek City Council to take every measure in protecting the city's traveling public


WHEREAS, The Rock Creek City Council wholly understands the lack of statewide funding available for transportation and safety improvements, and

WHEREAS, Trunk Highway 70 has a history of being a roadway within Pine County with an increased amount of traffic accidents including numerous serious injuries and fatalities.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Rock Creek City Council requests the Minnesota Department of Transportation prioritize Trunk Highway 70 for State and Federal funding to be appropriated for safety improvements along the Trunk Highway 70 Corridor, and

THEREFORE BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Rock Creek City Council also requests that the Minnesota State Patrol, in conjunction with the Pine County Sheriff's Office, increase patrol presence to help deter offenders from violating any such law or preventative measures in reducing motor vehicle accidents leading to harm and or death to those travelers within the Trunk Highway 70 Corridor.
