permits local correctional authorities to impose correctional fees.


Most, if not all, of the counties in Minnesota and the State Department of Corrections impose local correctional fees. The amount of local correctional fees can vary from jurisdiction to jurisdiction.

State law allows each jurisdiction to set their own fees and methods to administer the fees.

By law these fees are to be spent by the department for:

- community service work placement & supervision
- restitution collection
- **Supervision**
- court ordered investigations

Pine County has a one-time fee for each case file. Refer to your Invoice for detailed charges for your specific case.

All adult offenders are charged a one-time probation fee per case, based upon the period of probation ordered at the time of sentencing.

UNPAID FEES

If payment in full is not made in 60 days or at least a minimum monthly payment schedule is not arranged, your unpaid fees will be turned over to Pine County Collections.

Other means of collections will be pursued including a Revenue Recapture claim. This would mean that any State income tax refunds, property tax credits or refunds, and/or state rebates would be intercepted and paid towards your correctional fee. Any lottery winnings over \$ 600 can also be taken.
