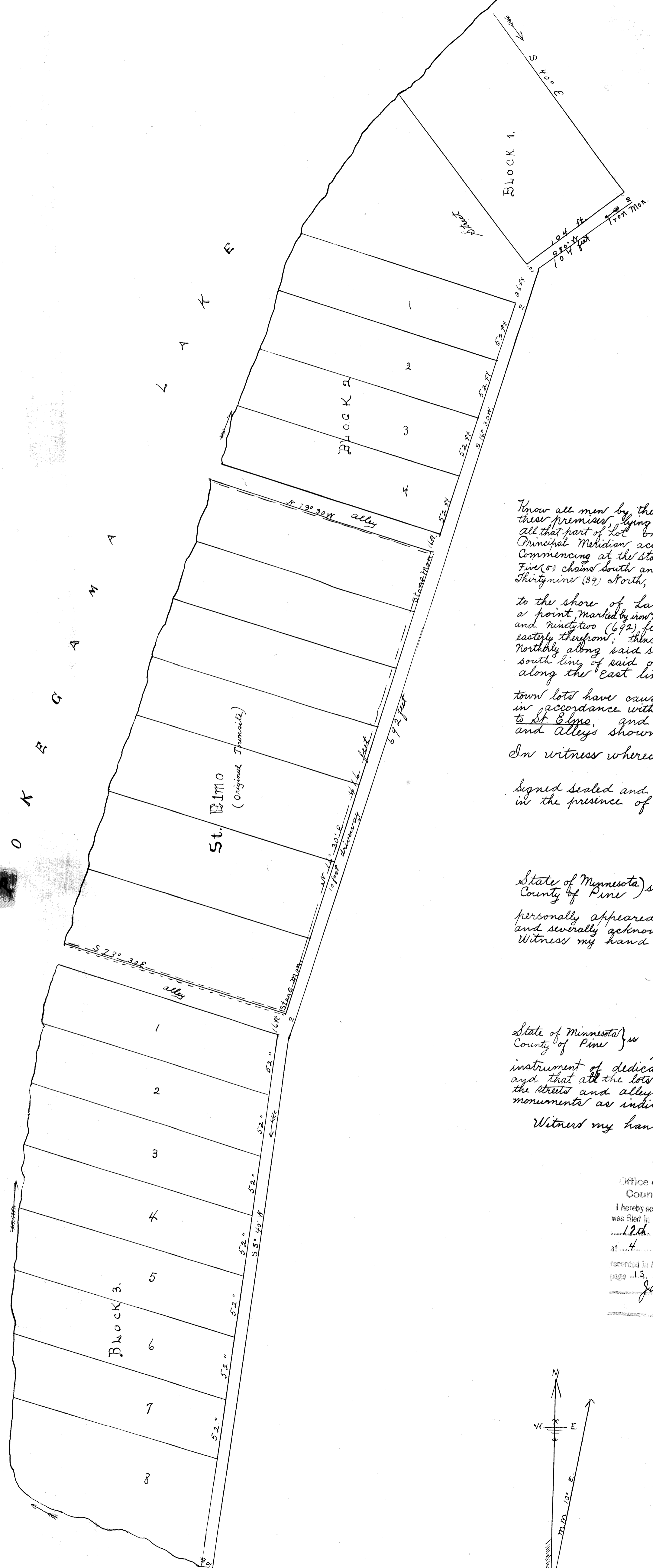


ASMUS' FIRST ADDITION
TO
ST. ELMO.



Know all men by these presents that we August Asmus and Pauline Asmus his wife, owners and proprietors of all these premises lying and being in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, known and described as follows, to-wit: all that part of lot one (1) in section Twenty-five (25) Township Thirty-nine (39) North, Range Twenty-two (22) West of the Fourth (4th) Principal Meridian according to the United States Government Survey thereof described as follows: Commencing at the Stone Monument at the Northeast corner of the original Townsite of St. Elmo, said corner being located Five (5) chains South and Thirty-eight (38) chains Four (4) links West of the Northeast corner of said section Twenty-five (25) Township Thirty-nine (39) North, Range Twenty-two (22) West; thence running North 73° 30' W, along the Northline of said original Townsite to the shore of Lake Pokegama, thence Northeastly along the Lake shore to a point, thence South 40° East to a point marked by iron monument, thence South 50° West one hundred and four (104) feet to a point, thence South 16° 30' West six hundred and ninety-two (692) feet to a point, said last described line being parallel to the original Townsite of St. Elmo, and ten (10) feet easterly therefrom; thence South 5° 40' West to the shore of Lake Pokegama; thence North along said shore to a point; thence North along said shore to the southwest corner of the original Townsite of St. Elmo; thence South 73° 30' East, along the south line of said original townsite, to the Southeast corner thereof, thence North 16° 30' E Four hundred and Sixteen (416) feet along the East line of said original townsite, to the point of beginning.

And being desirous of platting the same into town lots have caused the same to be surveyed and platted as a town site and the annexed plat thereof made in accordance with the statutes in such cases made and provided, to be known as Asmus' First Addition to St. Elmo, and sign, seal and execute said plat, and hereby dedicate to public use forever the streets and Alleys shown on said plat.
