

PLAT OF BERGMAN, PINE COUNTY, MINN.

There is a town by the name of Grant, that Christian Bergman and August Bergman, his husband, of the town of Orlingama, county of Pine, and that of Minnesota, were and heretofore of all their business being and being in said county of Pine, and state of Minnesota, and decided as follows to wit: all that tract of eastern lands in (20) in town thirty-nine (39) Range thirty-four (34) West of the fourth (20) principal meridian, beginning at a point on the north line of said section, said point being on the ground and eight (8) feet east of the north line of said section, thence running south one thousand four hundred and thirty (1433) feet; thence east and parallel to the north line of the section one hundred and eighty four (184) feet to the corner of the section; thence running westerly along the balance to the north line of said section, said section being the distance of two hundred and sixty (260) feet to the point of beginning; thence west the same to the starting, as a corner to the town as the town of Bergman and the same has been laid out for some purpose as known above; and, in so doing, by deed and deeded to the public use here, all estate and interest as known above.

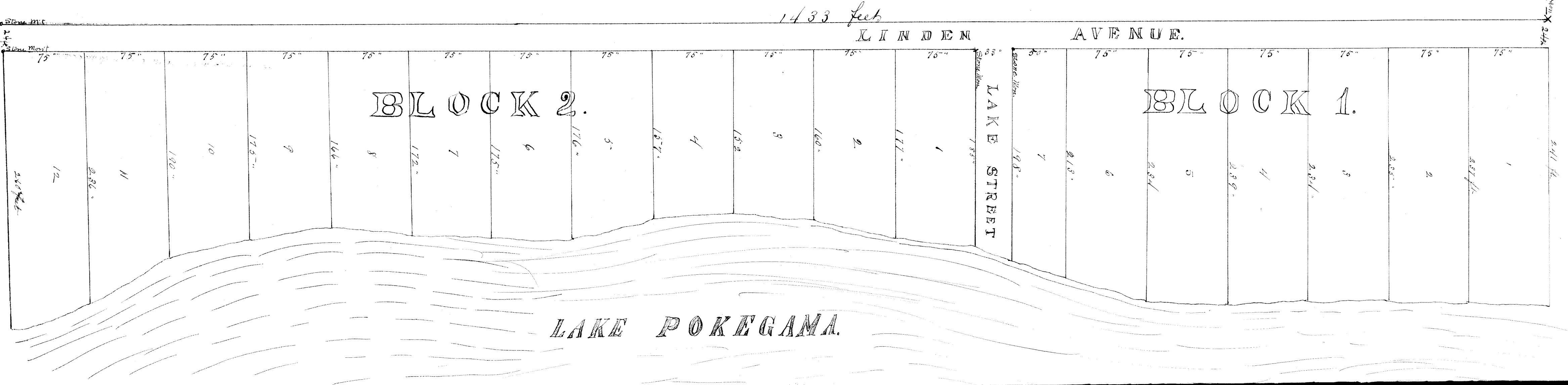
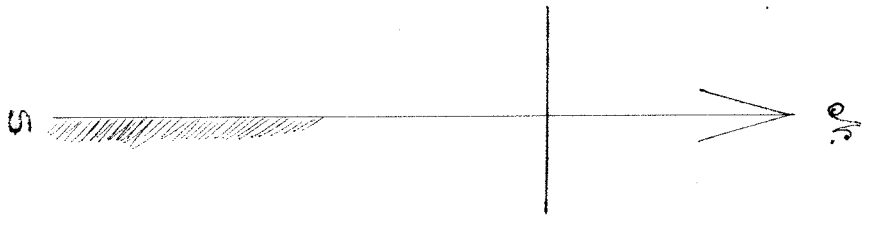
