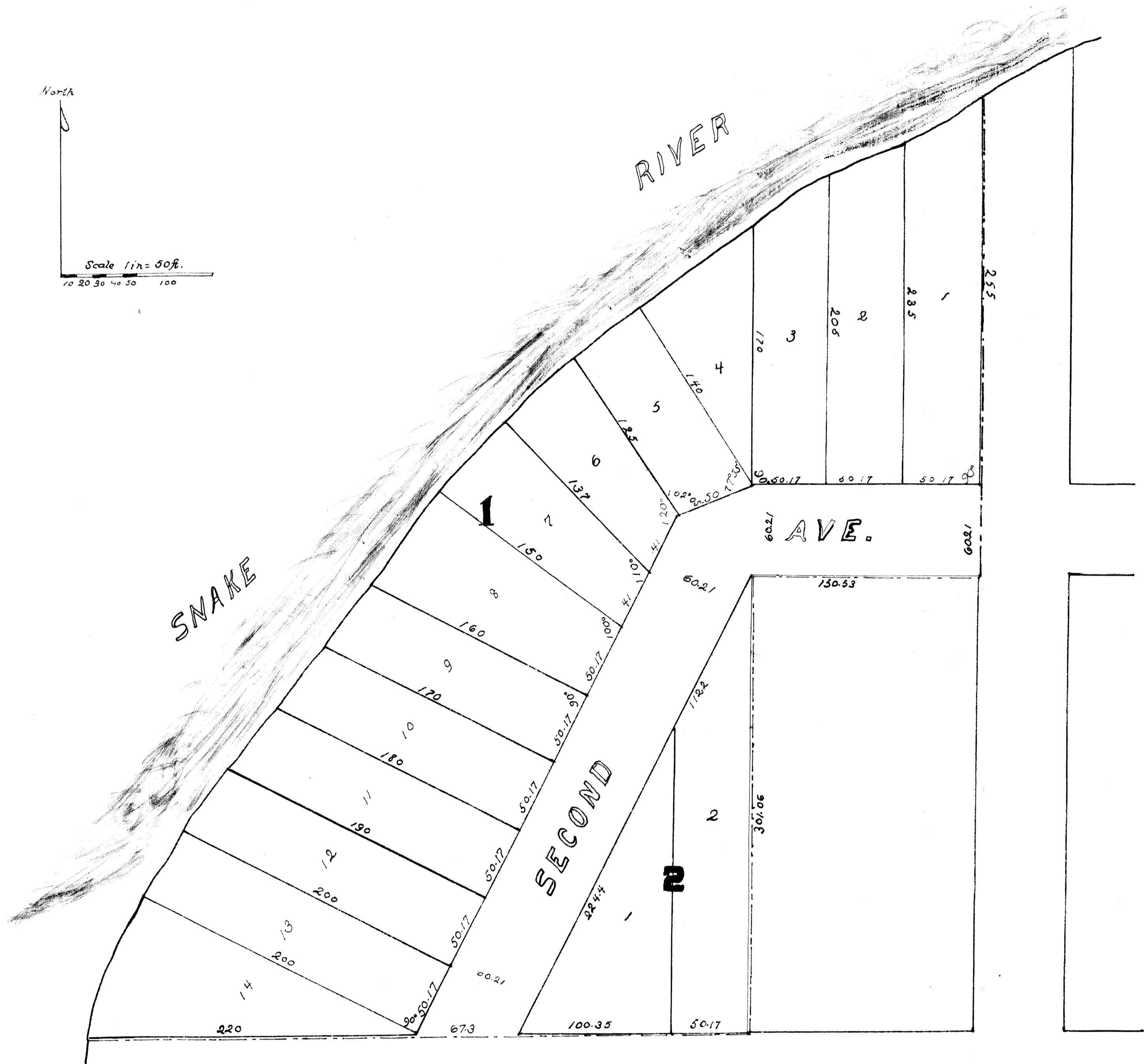
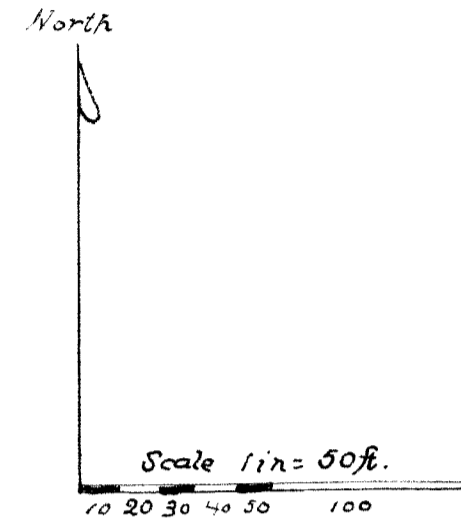


# CAMP'S RE-ARRANGEMENT OF BLOCK 14, PINE CITY.



KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That we, Chas. E. Camp and Catherine Z. Camp, his wife, of the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, owners and proprietors of the following described premises, to-wit: All of Block 14, Village of Pine City, excepting the following described tracts: Beginning at the Southeast corner of said Block 14, running thence North on East line of Block 14, 301.06 ft. to the South line of 2nd Ave prolonged; Thence West, on South line of 2nd Ave, 150.53 ft. Thence South 301.06 ft. to North line of 3rd Ave; Thence East, 150.53 ft. to place of beginning, and being desirous of re-arranging the same, have caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat thereof to be made in accordance with the Statutes in such cases made and provided, to be known as "Camp's Re-arrangement of Block 14 Pine City," and hereby dedicate to public use forever, the streets shown on annexed plat.
