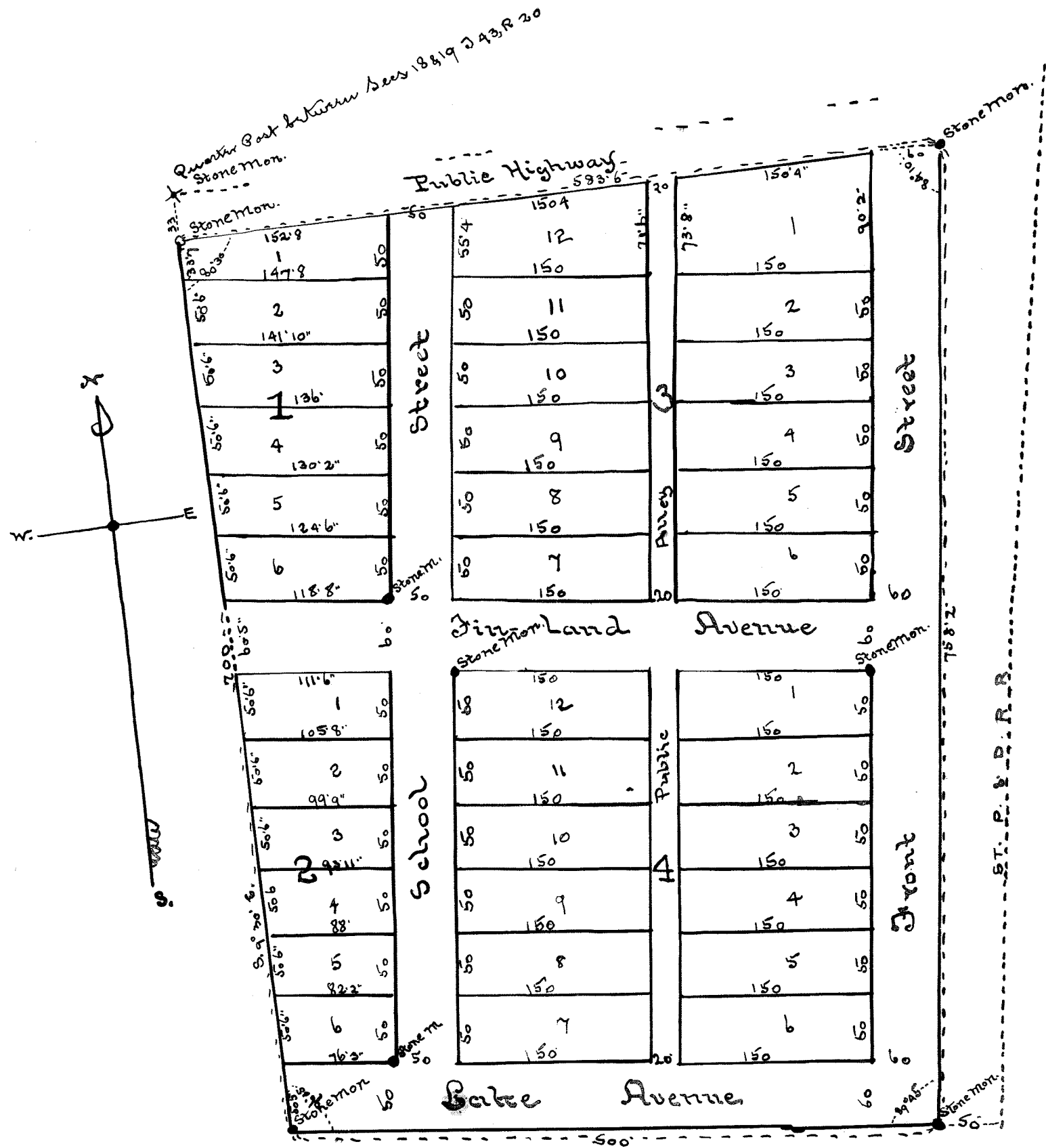


PLAT OF THE TOWN OF FINLAYSON

I Oscar Oswald & Kingston Lake, Minnesota, County Surveyor for the County of Pine in said State, do hereby certify that I have surveyed and laid out and plotted for and by force and virtue of the Statute of the State of Minnesota, the Town of Finlayson, Pine County, Minnesota, and that the plat or map hereto annexed is a true and correct copy of that I have caused stone monuments to be placed or firmly fixed in the ground as indicated on said map; that all the lots, streets and alleys are laid out according to the dimensions in feet and inches.

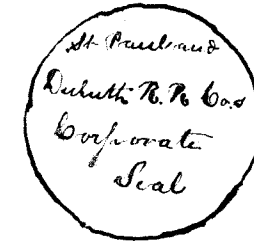

The Saint Paul and Duluth Railroad Company, Proprietor of the Town of Finlayson, Pine County, Minnesota, hereby certifies that it has caused the same to be surveyed and the annexed plat hereof to be made; that the same is surveyed and laid out upon the following described parcel of land situated in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, to-wit: On part of the Northwest quarter of the Northeast quarter (12th of 16th) of Section Nineteen (19) Township Forty Three (43) North of Range Twenty (20) West of the Fourth Principal Meridian, and bounded and described as follows, viz: Beginning at a stone monument thirty three (33) feet South of the quarter post between Sections Eighteen (18) and Nineteen (19) Township Forty Three (43) North of Range Twenty (20) thence running South nine degrees and thirty minutes East (S. 9° 30' E) in a magnetic variation, seven hundred (700) feet to a stone monument, running thence in an easterly direction, at an angle of ninety six degrees and thirty five minutes (96° 35') five hundred (500) feet to a stone monument, thence running in a northerly direction, at an angle of eighty nine degrees and forty five minutes (89° 45') seven hundred and fifty eight feet and two inches (758' 2") to a stone monument, running thence in a westerly direction at an angle of eighty four degrees and two minutes (84° 02') five hundred and eighty three feet and six inches (583' 6") to the point or place of beginning.

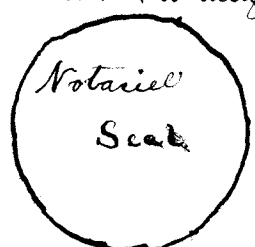
