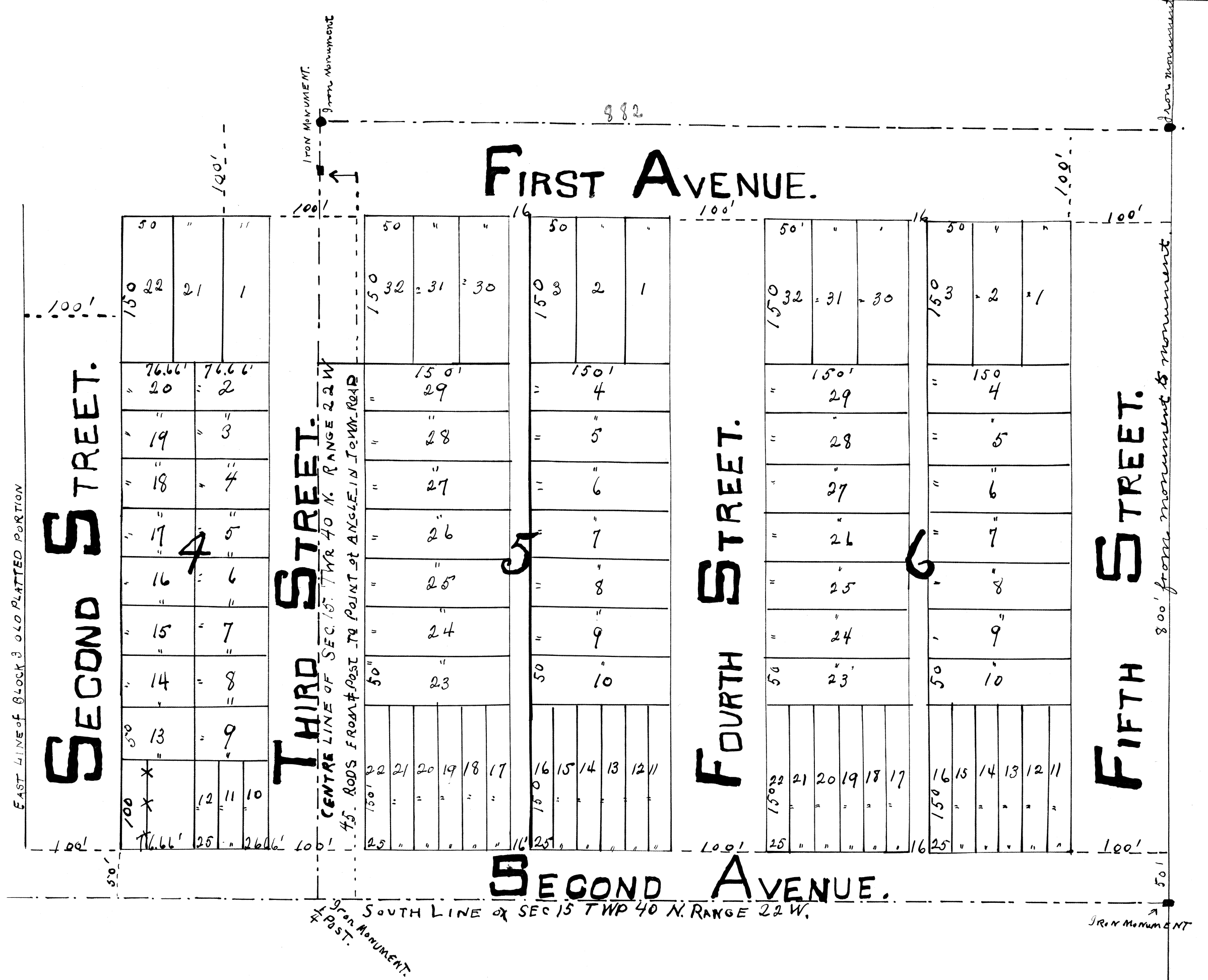


**PLAN

Know all men by these presents: that we Isabella Kelley and Chauncey A. Kelley owners of these premises lying and being in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota, known and described as follows, to wit: On the southwest quarter (7) of the southeast quarter (7) of Section 15 in Township 40, Range 22 West of the fourth (4) P. M. beginning at the quarter post on the south line of said Sec. 15 and to Range 22, running thence north on the center line eight hundred (800) feet, thence east eight hundred and eighty-two (882) feet, thence south eight hundred (800) feet, thence west eight hundred and eighty-two (882) feet, to point of beginning, have succeeded the same to be platted as an addition to the townsite of Brookpark, Minn. that it and that part of the formerly platted portion of the townsite of Brookpark, not divided into lots and blocks has been laid out as hereon shown, and we do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all the streets, avenues and alleys as hereon shown.
