Know all men by these presents: That we, John G. Lind and Helvig F. Lind, his wife, as owners of the following described real estate in Pine County, Minnesota, to wit: All that part of Government Lot 3, Sec. 25, T 39, R 22, described as follows: Commencing at the Northeast corner of Government Lot 4, Sec 25, T 39, R 22, thence West along said North line of the Government Lot for a distance of 370.0 feet, said point being the point of beginning, also described as point A; thence West along the North line of said Government Lot 4 to the shore of Pokegama Lake, said point being designated point B. Thence commencing again at point A and running Northeast to a point on the North line of said Government Lot 3, which point is 984.8 feet West of the Northeast corner of said Government Lot 3; thence West along the North line of said Government Lot 3 to the shore of Pokegama Lake, thence Southwesterly along the shore of Pokegama Lake to point B, (Book 121, Page 307); shown in detail on the annexed plat, have caused the same to be surveyed and platted into lots by Dallas Dale Fowler, Pine County Surveyor, and named and designated "Lind's East Shore", and have caused the annexed plat to be made according to the statutes.
