Know all men by these presents: That I, Frank J. 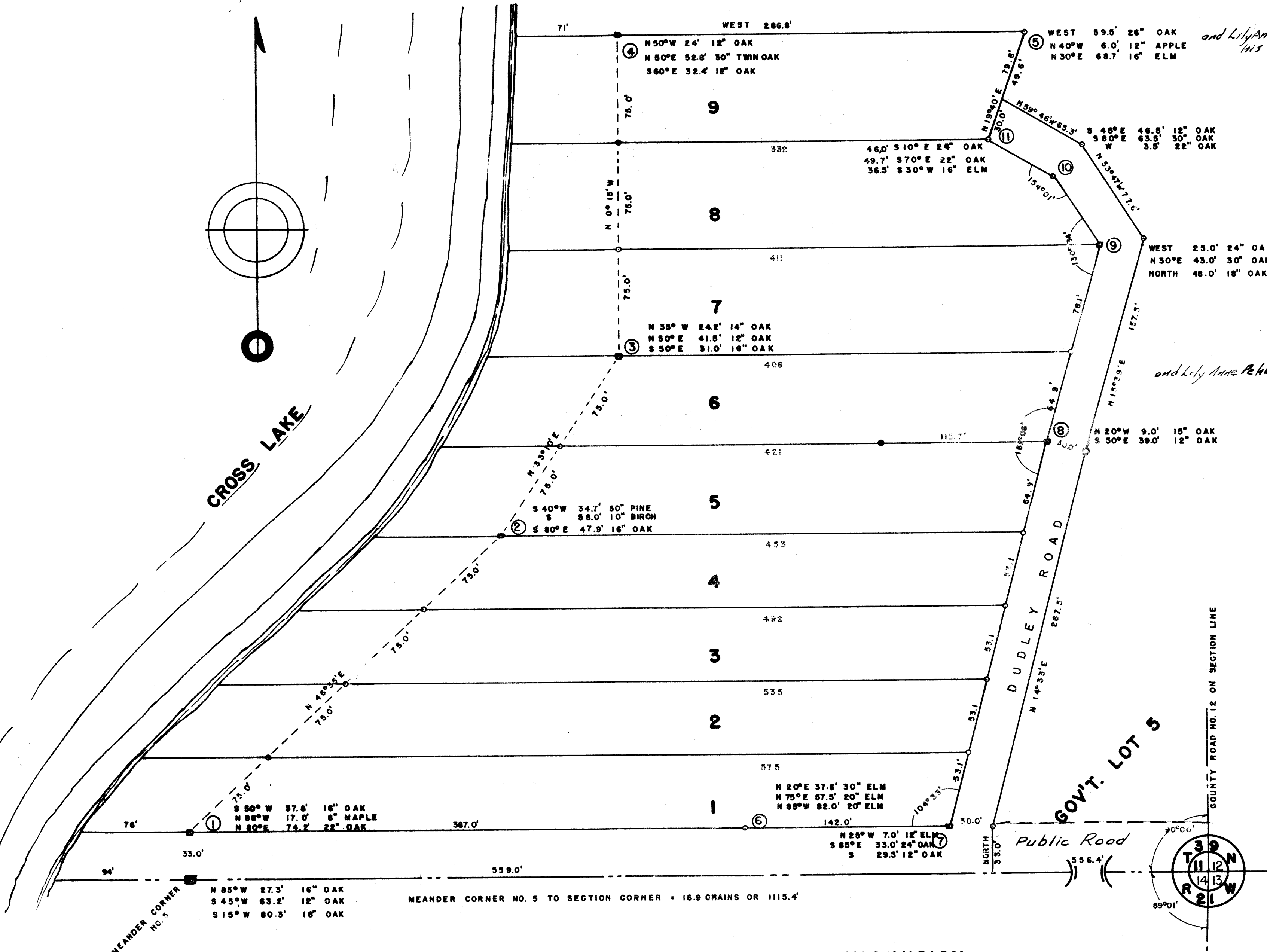
