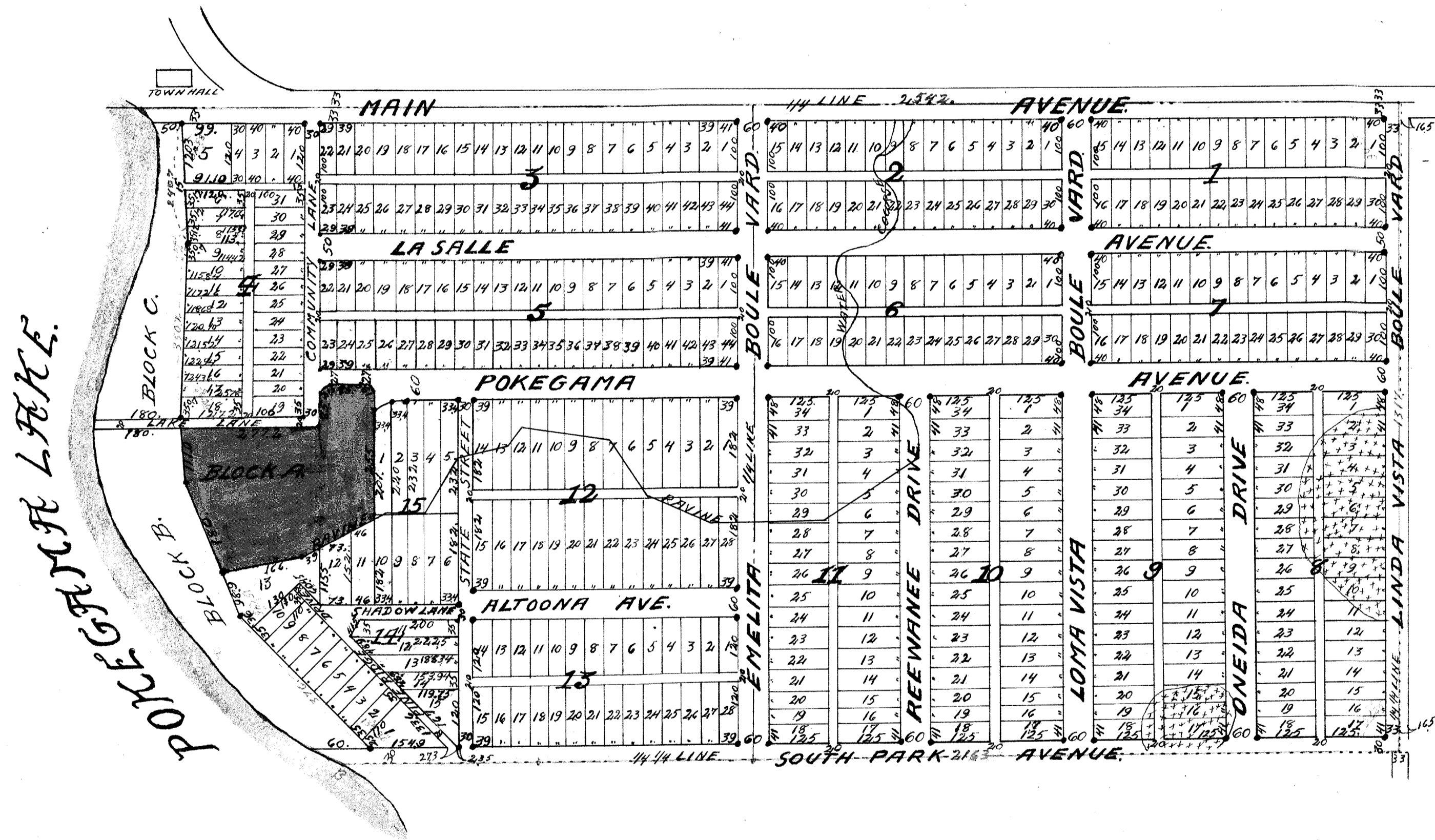


POKEGAMA LAKE ADDITION
