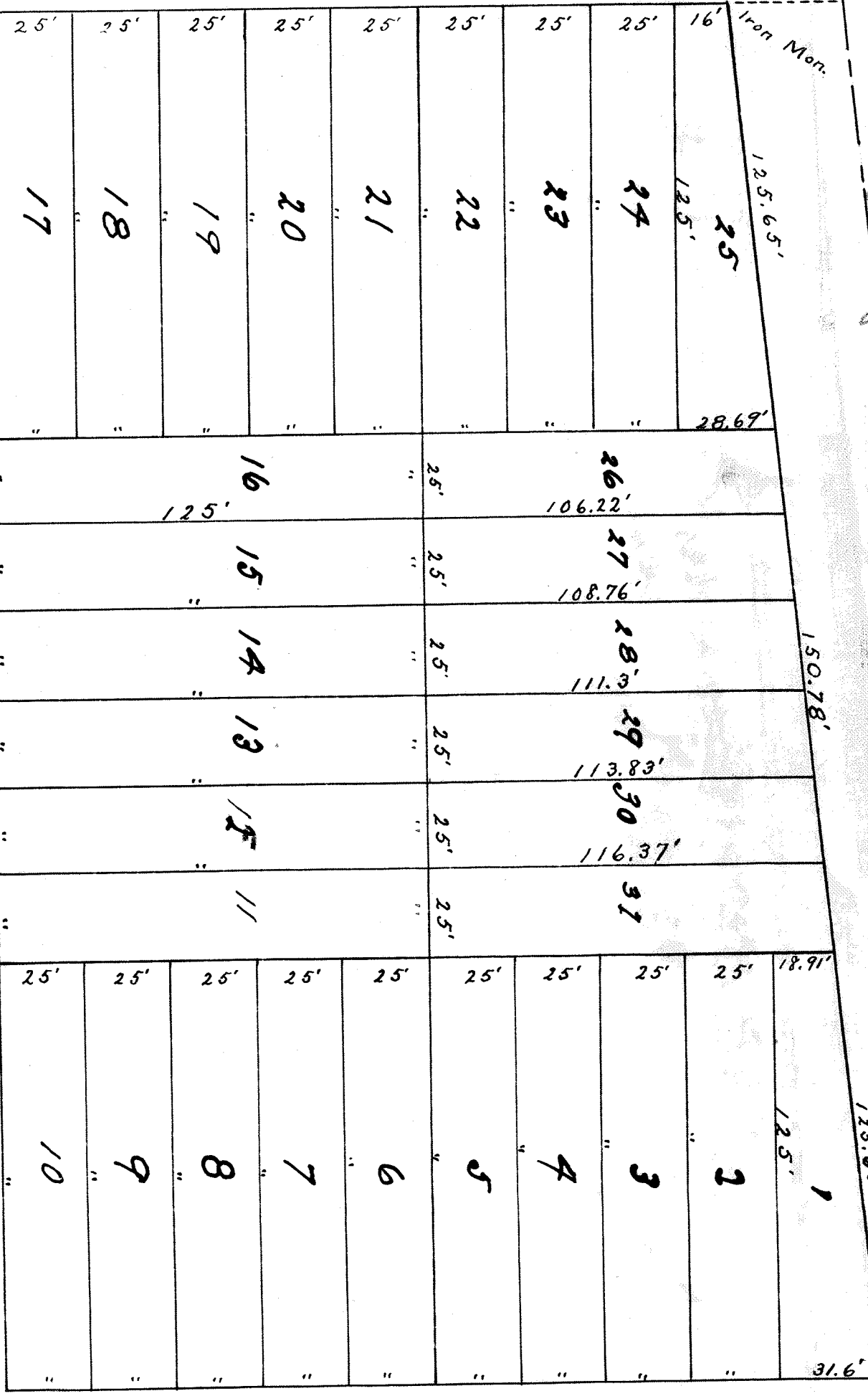


# REARRANGEMENT OF BLOCK 1 OF FOLSOM'S FIRST ADDITION TO HINCKLEY, MINN.

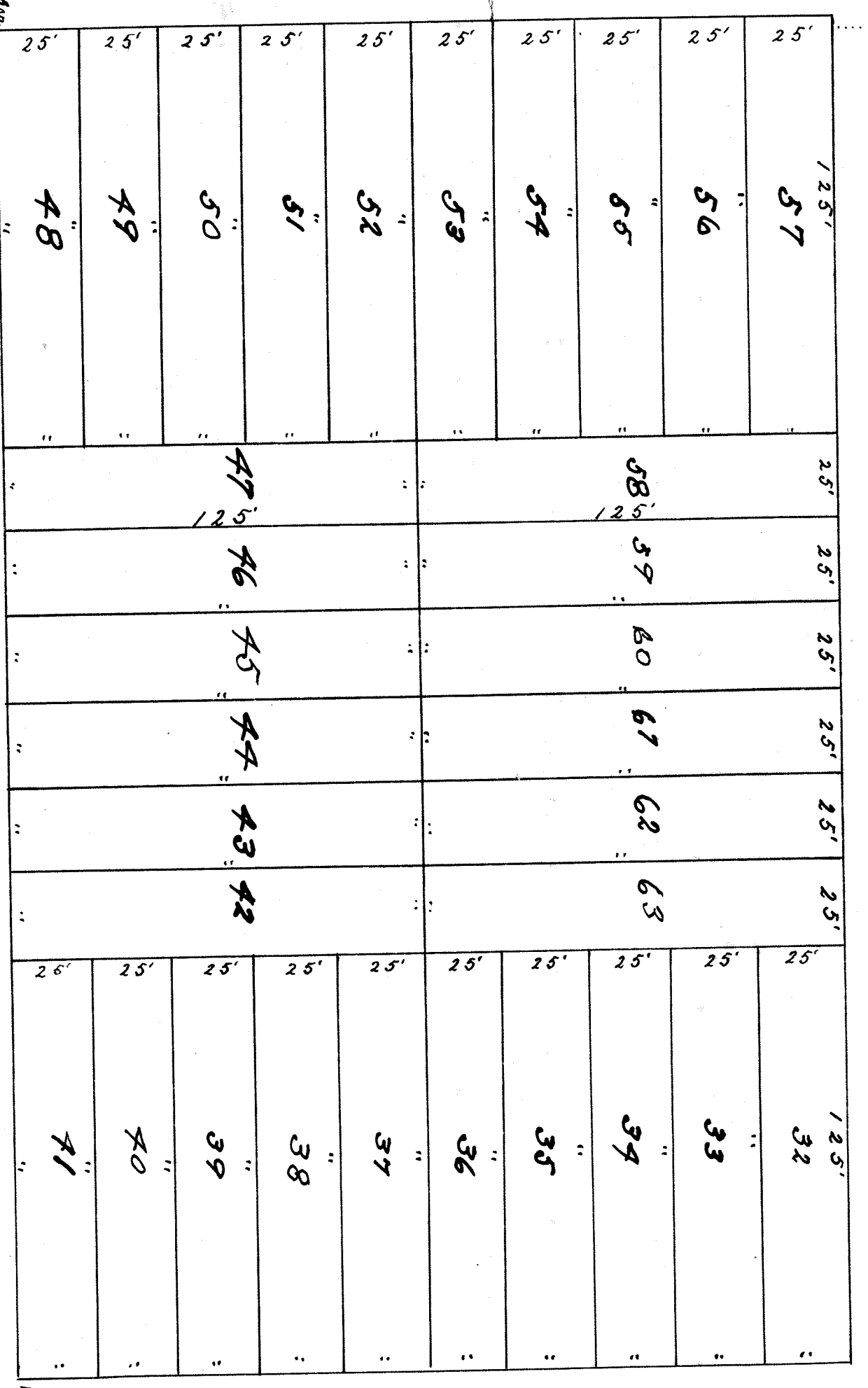
