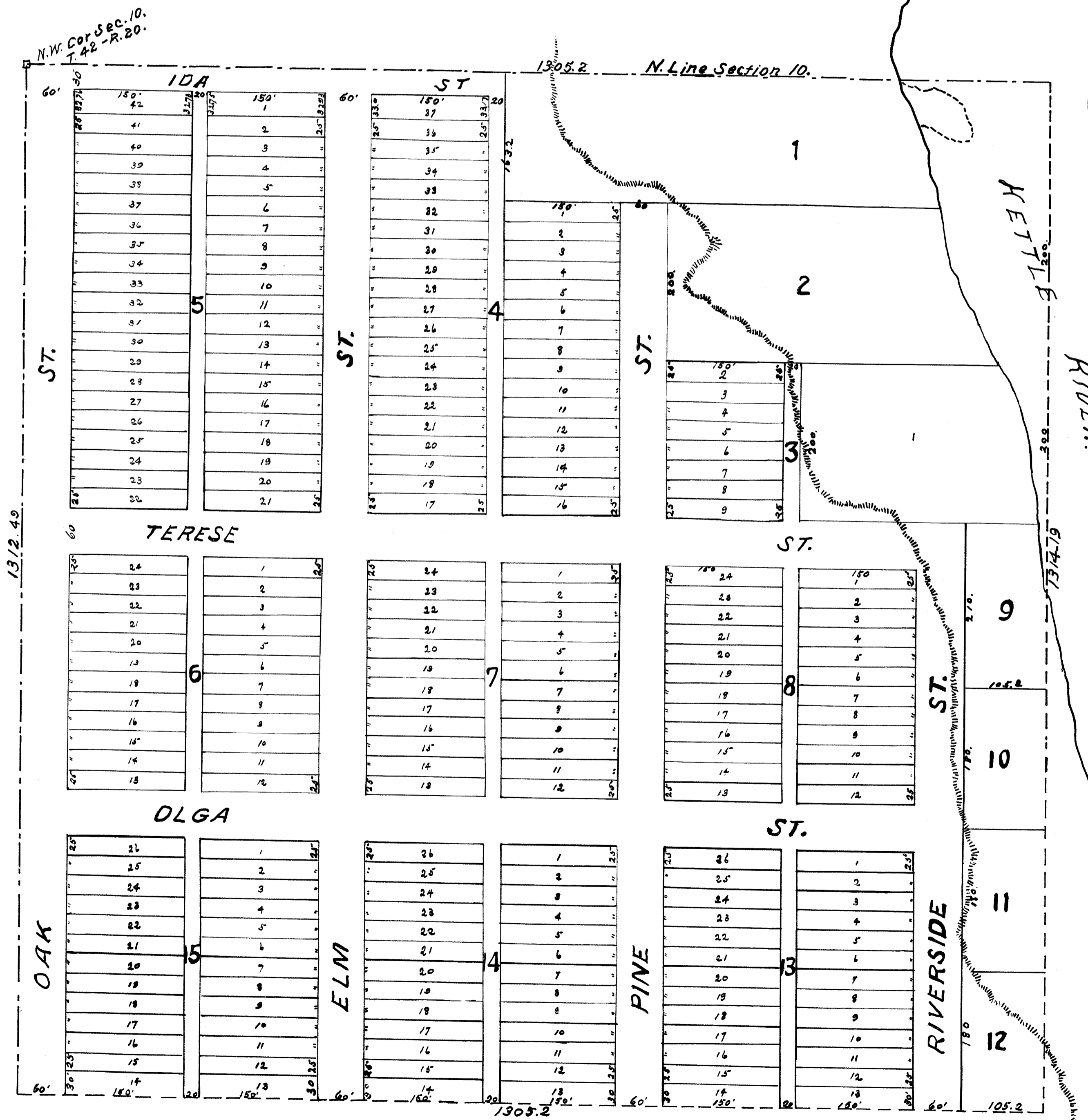


RIVERSIDE ADDITION TO SANDSTONE, PINE CO. MINN.
