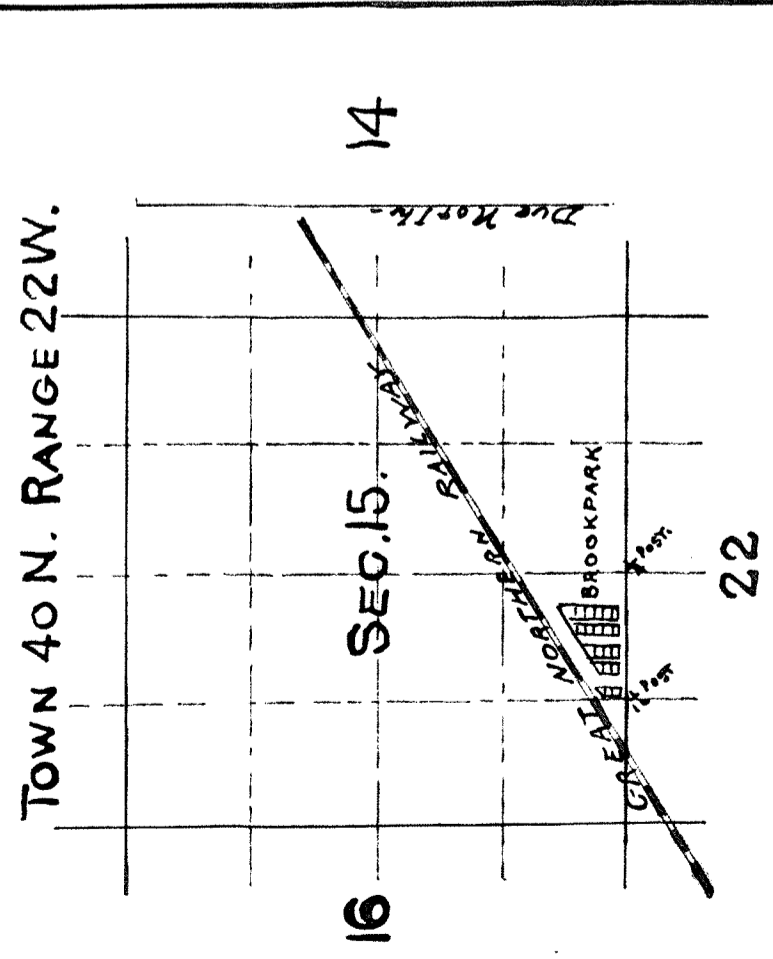
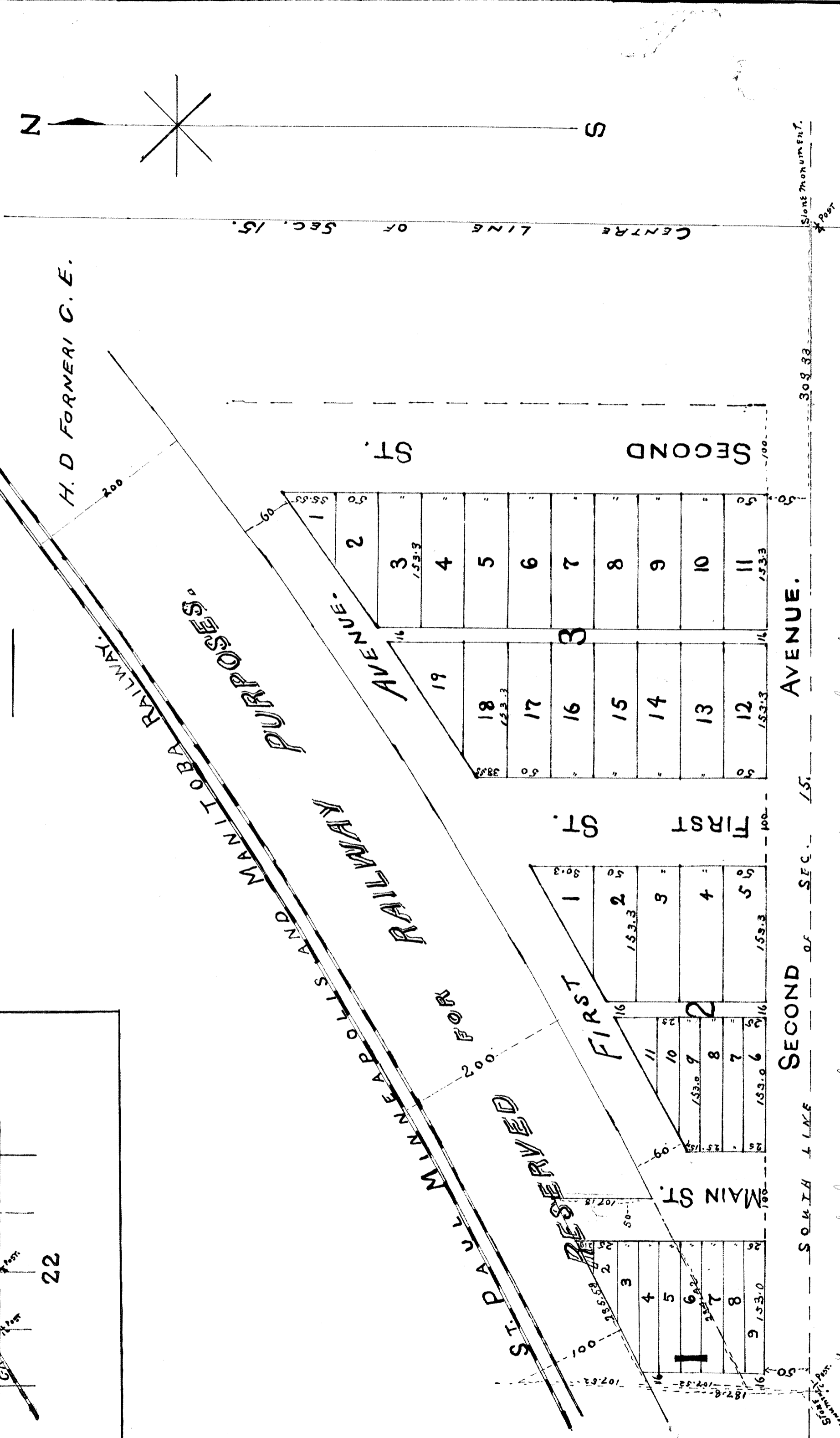


POSITION OF THE

Know all men by these presents, that we Guyon J. Kelley and wife, Mary S. Kelley and Geo. W. Markham and wife, Addie A. Markham owners of all of the premises lying and being in the County of Pine and State of Minnesota and known as described as follows to-wit: All that part of the South East quarter (SE 1/4) of the South West quarter (SW 1/4) of Section fifteen (15) in Township forty, 40 Range twenty-two (22), west of the 4th P.M. lying south and east of the right of way of the St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba Railroad of Minnesota, as now constructed, described more particularly as follows to-wit: Commencing at the south west corner of said SE 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 15 (15) 40 R. 22 running thence north on the one hundred and eighty seven and 1/2 (187.5) feet to the right of way of said St. Paul, Minneapolis and Manitoba R.R. thence northwesterly along said right of way two hundred and thirty three and fifty eight hundredths (233.58) feet, thence south one hundred and seven and eight hundredths (107.18) feet, thence a westerly course along said right of way of said R.R. on the south and east side thereof to the entire line of said Section fifteen (15) thence south on said line to the quarter post on the south side of said Section fifteen (15) thence west on said Section line to the place of beginning, have caused the same to be platted as a Township to be known as Township of Brook Park, that it has been laid out for town purposes as hereon shown and we do hereby donate and dedicate to the public use forever all streets, avenues and alleys as hereon shown.
